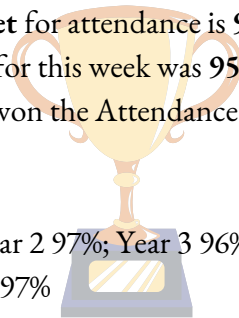

What Three Questions?

Nursery

What animals live in the arctic?

Can you clap the number of syllables in your name?

Can you hear and copy sounds from your environment?

Reception
